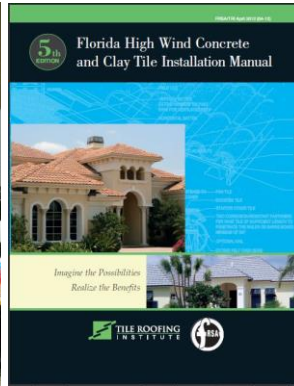

**High Wind Manual Certification** - The High Wind Installation Manual Certification class is for entry level and experienced roofers who want to expand their skills and understanding of the 5th Edition FRSA/TRI High Wind Installation manual. The class is also helpful for roof consultants, home inspectors and industry professionals who work with tile roofing. Those who pass the multiple choice test can market their knowledge using the High Wind Certification logo on their website and marketing materials. They will also be listed on the TRI contractor search at [www.tilerooting.org/find-contractor](http://www.tilerooting.org/find-contractor).
